School Lunches

School lunches for pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are free under the UIFSM scheme. Unfortunately, once your child enters Year 3, they are no longer eligible for this. School lunches are then charged at £2.65. We believe the standard of our lunches are high, incredibly good value and meet the nutrition guidelines. Nursery meals are also chargeable and cost £1.95.
