#### St Peter's Church

I recently received an update and now know that it will be March 2023 when the recruitment process will begin for a new Vicar. In the meantime, we will continue to support and access Church as much as is possible.

#### **Extra-Curricular Clubs**

New clubs are starting this week and run until week commencing 5<sup>th</sup> December. Every half term we always run new clubs therefore there will never be clubs in the first week when the new list is being finalised, distributed and bookings made.

#### **Road Safety Week**

This takes place week commencing Monday 14<sup>th</sup> November however is always a priority for ISP. Our pupils, through School Parliament, are aware of the local issues and will continue to raise awareness of this. After speaking to Councilor Edwards, who is a member of our Governing Body, he advised that any dangerous driving be reported to the Police. This way, the log will show a clearer picture of the dangers and concerns approaching the crossing and the at the crossing.

I have been updated and the following works will be complete by March 2023:

- \*New school flashing light units, integral with school warning signs and an advisory 20mph speed limit (when lights flash) with yellow backing boards.
- \*A possible Speed Indication Device (SID) to highlight speeds and indicate "slow down" to drivers on approach to Ireleth from the north.
- \*Reinforcing of the existing speed limit and consideration of a buffer before the 30mph speed limit entry point (this is already in existence as it is 40mph prior to the 30mph), however consideration of improvements to the existing arrangement.
- \*Consideration of safety barriers approaching from the south on the bend.
- \*An Engineering Safety Study within the 2022/2023 year for the A595 covering the approach to Ireleth and into the village. This is programmed in and is currently out as part of a tender package, with planned outsourcing to independent consultants through our framework provision.

It is hoped that the work will be completed in advance of March 2023 which does seem a long time away when we all know how urgent additional safety measures are. Special thanks to our Parent Governor, Siobhan Johnston for her support and perseverance with this. Thanks also to School Parliament, Janice Cummings from The Parish Council and Councilor Shirley.

#### **Winter Weather**

As the cold and wet months approach us, please ensure your child is sent to school with a warm coat. Hat and gloves can also be sent when needed but please do ensure they are named for obvious reasons. If we wake up to snow, a decision will be made as to whether I can open school by 7:45am. This be dependent on staff availability along with the health and safety of all pupils, families and staff. You will be informed via Class Dojo and ParentMail.

#### **Health and Safety**

A couple of points worth noting:
Whilst it is fine for your child/ren to play on the adventure playground after school, please note that they are not covered by our insurance once in your care. I would also politely request that you do not allow your child/ren to climb on the wall, banking or railings. They are not allowed to do this in school time and consistency would be appreciated.


